MIAMI BEACH - The Miami Design Preservation League continues its “Made in Miami Beach” film series with a free screening of *Radio Inside* (1994) on Tuesday, October 9 at 7:00 p.m. at the Art Deco Welcome Center. Experience the twists and turns of a love triangle between two brothers in this film shot in South Beach’s Flamingo Park neighborhood.

*Radio Inside* is a story of two brothers Matt (William McNamara) and Mike (Dylan Walsh) who fall in love with the same woman, Natalie (Elisabeth Shue). Although Natalie is dating Mike, she feels an attraction to Matt. During the love triangle, both brothers struggle with another personal issue – the accidental drowning of their father. Matt retreats into his own world and begins to think that there is a radio inside his head that switches stations each time life becomes more difficult.

“Radio Inside” is the first of three films in Miami Design Preservation League’s 2007 made-in-Miami Beach series entitled “Square Pegs in Round Holes.” The series welcomes viewers into the world of characters who struggle to fit in whether it be unrecognized love, fear of commitment, or notions of family. These characters search for acceptance and meaning, capturing life in Miami Beach during the final years of the 1990s.

*Radio Inside* is part of a series of free lectures, films and exhibits presented by the Miami Design Preservation League throughout the year.
